Is Your Dog Suddenly Acting Grouchy???

There might be a physical reason for it! Low thyroid (hypothyroidism) will cause aggression and a radical change of personality in a dog that used to be calm. Have your vet send the thyroid test to Michigan State for a full range of values. Once on thyroid meds, dogs will usually return to their former selves.

Pain will also cause a dog to act grouchy, arthritis in older dogs will cause the dogs to snap when they are touched in areas of their bodies that are sore. Sometimes children stumble against the old dog, and cause pain in a sensitive area.

Have your vets do a physical if your pets looks and acts out of sorts, chances are, there will be a physical reason for it. Remember, they cannot tell you where it hurts!

Are You getting a Puppy this Summer?

Don't forget, by Florida law, all dogs sold MUST have a health certificate issued by a veterinarian. Do not fall into the trap of accepting a puppy with a "pending" health certificate. Also, if you are buying a purebred puppy, AKC requires that the breeder issue a litter registration form with each puppy at the time of purchase, which you can use to register your puppy individually and under your own name. Once again, do not fall for the "papers are coming" excuse. All litters can now be registered online with AKC.
