This coming weekend, September 30, October 1 & 2, is our USDAA Agility competition. This is the biggest USDAA (United States Agility Association) trial we have ever had. We have over 1000 runs over the weekend. There will be many dogs competing, including some World Team Dogs, with some very well known handlers in the agility world. This promises to be a great show to watch if you are interested in doing agility with your furry friends!

The Mosaic Arena, where the show will be held has beautiful bleachers for spectators and admission and parking are free. Everyone is invited, directions to the arena: From I-75: Take exit 224 (The Ellenton Mall Exit) onto US 301 westbound. It becomes 10th St. W. in Palmetto. Continue to 14th Ave. You will cross US 41 and business 41. Turn right onto 14th Ave. and continue to the fairground entrance on your right.
